<b>Title:</b>	<b>Falling Objects Compliance Campaign</b>

<b>Background:</b>	<p>Recently, a young worker on another builder’s site on the Gold Coast tragically lost their life due to being struck by a part falling from a concrete boom pump. This highlights the critical importance of safe work practices to control the risks of falling objects.</p> <p>Starting February 2026, Workplace Health and Safety Queensland (WHSQ) have commenced a statewide compliance campaign targeting falling object risks on construction sites. Inspectors are focusing on high-risk activities like crane lifts, scaffolding, on-roof works, etc. SafeWork NSW has also identified falling objects as a key compliance and enforcement priority, with increased inspections and regulatory attention across construction projects.</p>		
<b>Direction to Coral Homes Contractors:</b>	<p>All Contractors must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure you have adequate controls in place to protect workers who are working below areas of potential falling objects (including but not limited to; crane activities, on-roof works, on scaffold works)</li> <li>• Ensure your SWMS are compliant, and all workers are trained, signed off, and following their SWMS daily</li> <li>• Ensure all of your workers have completed the Coral Homes General Worker Induction (accessible via the QR code on the site sign)</li> <li>• Ensure you complete Coral Homes Mobile Plant Induction <b>every time you bring mobile plant onto a Coral Homes site</b></li> <li>• Maintain exclusion zones &amp; containment, good housekeeping, and safe material storage</li> </ul> <p>Coral Homes representatives and Safety Advisors will be supervising compliance over the coming weeks.</p> <p>Read the full WHSQ article: <a href="#">Falling Objects Compliance Campaign – WHSQ</a></p> <p>Thank you for your ongoing commitment to ensure the safety of all workers on site.</p>
